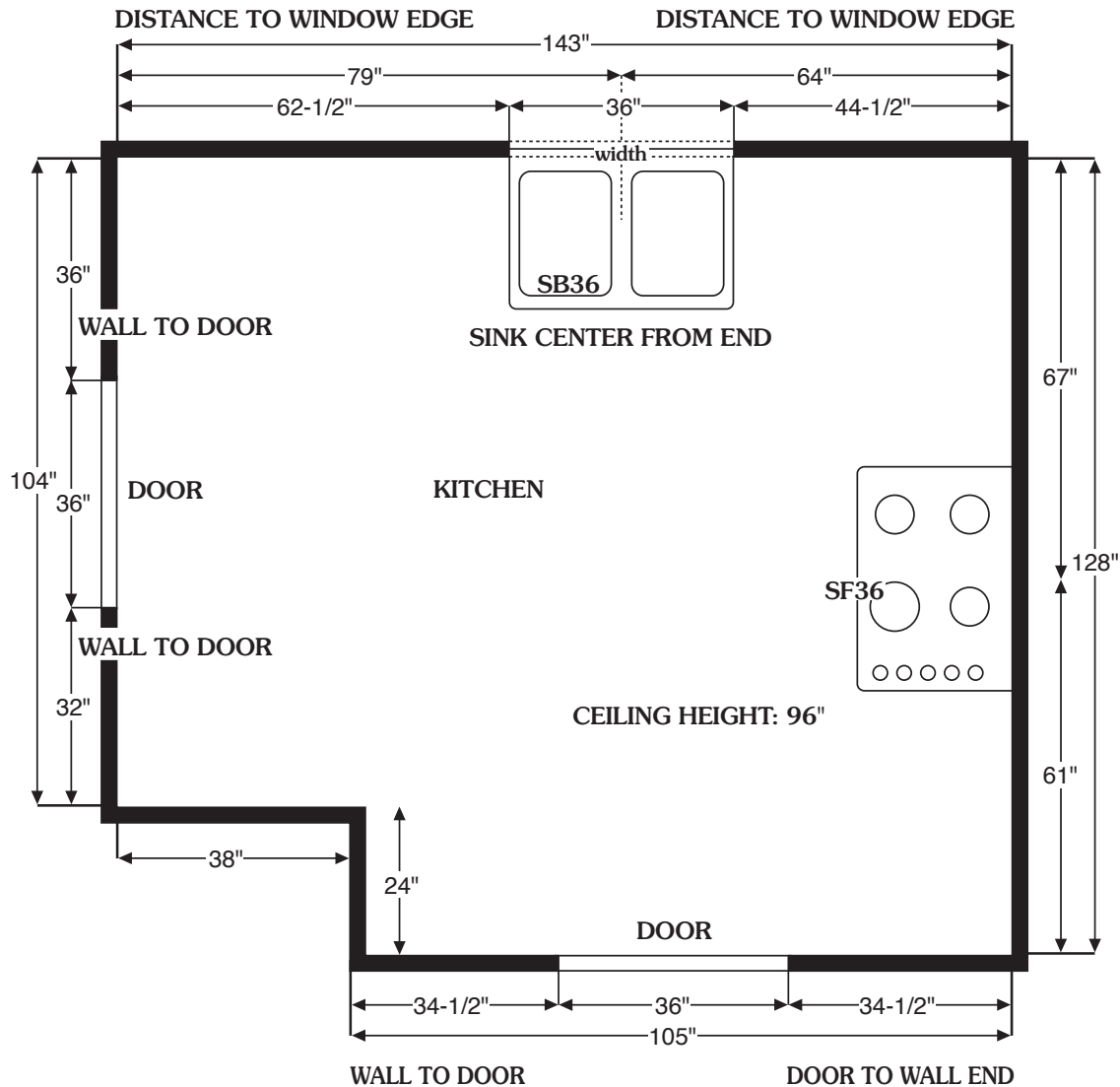


THE KITCHEN WAREHOUSE

How to Measure Your Kitchen



- Draw a sketch of your kitchen following the above diagram as a sample of the information required. Show all window and door openings. Measurement of door and window openings should include moldings.
- Fill in all dimensions. Measure each section of the wall and the overall dimension of the wall. The total of the sections should add up to the overall wall dimension.
- Measure ceiling height or measure from the floor to the bottom of the soffits if soffits are involved.
- Measure all existing appliances that are going to be used in the kitchen. Show whether refrigerator or freezer hinges are on the left or right side of the appliance.
- Do not measure existing cabinets. Measure kitchen walls as though the kitchen was bare.
